Dear Ms Kelley,

The aim of this study was to determine the virucidal activity of WWS-716 antibacterial formulation against NIBRG-121 influenza virus, an attenuated form of the H1N1 swine influenza virus. NIBRG-121 was incubated in the presence of WWS-716 and the amount of infectious influenza virus remaining subsequently quantified by titration on MDCK cells. WWS-716 was shown to exhibit virucidal activity as no infectious influenza virus was detected following incubation of the virus with WWS-716. The results indicate that WWS-716 was shown to kill at least 90% of the influenza virus but it was not possible to determine from the experiments if greater than 90% of the virus had been killed as toxicity of the test article to the MDCK cell line may have prevented virus detection beyond the 90 % reduction level.
